Warriner Trophy Competition

Subject To be chosen by the members after each preceding Warriner competition.

Awards 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall.

Points towards the Grand Prix for each member.

Judging By all non-competing club members allocating points according to positions, which are then added together to give the overall placing.

1 st = 10 points	3 rd = 8 points	5 th = 6 points	7 th = 4 points	9 th = 2 points
2 nd = 9 points	4 th = 7 points	6 th = 5 points	8 th = 3 points	All others = 1 point

Rules of Entry for the Warriner Trophy Competition

1. An individual member or a group including a member is acceptable.
2. Entries must **NOT** exceed **5 minutes**.
3. The Club provides for Super 8 film, SVHS, Mini DV video, Blue Ray DVD, Multimedia SD Card & USB Pen. The responsibility for the viewing of any other format lies with the entrant.
4. The use of professional or archive material is permissible. All professional and archive material must be acknowledged in the credits. Excessive use of third party material will be taken into account by the judges
5. Only one entry per member is allowed.
6. Care will be taken with all entries but the Club cannot accept liability for damage or loss.
7. Entry to the Competition is free but the entrant must arrange delivery and collection of the movie.

Awards 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall.

Points towards the Grand Prix for each member.

Judging By all non-competing club members allocating points according to positions, which are then added together to give the overall placing.

1 st = 10 points	3 rd = 8 points	5 th = 6 points	7 th = 4 points	9 th = 2 points
2 nd = 9 points	4 th = 7 points	6 th = 5 points	8 th = 3 points	All others = 1 point

1. An individual member or a group including a member is acceptable.
2. Entries must **NOT** exceed **12 minutes**.
3. The Club provides for Super 8 film, SVHS, Mini DV video and Blue Ray DVD, Multimedia SD Card & USB Pen. The responsibility for the viewing of any other format lies with the entrant.
4. The use of professional or archive material is permissible. All professional and archive material must be acknowledged in the credits. Excessive use of third party material will be taken into account by the judges

3. The Club provides for Super 8 film, SVHS, Mini DV video and Blue Ray DVD, Multimedia SD Card & USB Pen. The responsibility for the viewing of any other format lies with the entrant.
4. The use of professional or archive material is permissible. All professional and archive material must be acknowledged in the credits. Excessive use of third party material will be taken into account by the judges
5. Only one entry per member is allowed.
6. An entrant must not have won an individual club competition before, including the annual competition categories.
7. Entrants are not included in the Grand Prix Trophy with this competition.
8. Care will be taken with all entries but the Club cannot accept liability for damage or loss.
9. Entry to the Competition is free but the entrant must arrange delivery and collection of the movie.

Judging By all non-competing club members allocating points according to positions, which are then added together to give the overall placing.

1 st = 10 points	3 rd = 8 points	5 th = 6 points	7 th = 4 points	9 th = 2 points
2 nd = 9 points	4 th = 7 points	6 th = 5 points	8 th = 3 points	All others = 1 point

Rules of Entry for the Dave Sephton Trophy Competition

1. An individual member or a group including a member is acceptable.
2. Entries must **NOT** exceed **1 minute**.
3. The Club provides for Super 8 film, SVHS, Mini DV video and Blue Ray DVD, Multimedia SD Card & USB Pen. The responsibility for the viewing of any other format lies with the entrant.
4. The use of professional or archive material is permissible. All professional and archive material must be acknowledged in the credits. Excessive use of third party material will be taken into account by the judges
5. A maximum of 3 entries per member is allowed.
6. Care will be taken with all entries but the Club cannot accept liability for damage or loss.
7. Entry to the Competition is free but the entrant must arrange delivery and collection of the movie.

Rules of Entry for the Annual Competition

1. An individual member or a group including a member is acceptable.
2. Each category must have at least two entries to run. If a category has less than two entries, the entrants will be given the option to withdraw or enter it in the Open Category.
3. Entries must **NOT** exceed **12 minutes**.
4. The Club provides for Super 8 film, SVHS, Mini DV video and Blue Ray DVD, Multimedia SD Card & USB Pen. The responsibility for the viewing of any other format lies with the entrant.
5. The use of professional or archive material is permissible. All professional and archive material must be acknowledged in the credits. Excessive use of third party material will be taken into account by the judges
6. Only one entry per member per category is allowed except when an entry is transferred to the open category due to insufficient entries in another. Any entry can only be included in one category.
7. Entries will not be previous Annual Competition winners.
8. Entry forms must be submitted to the Secretary no later than **ONE WEEK** before the Competition date.
9. Care will be taken with all entries but the Club cannot accept liability for damage or loss.
10. Entry to the Competition is free but the entrant must arrange delivery and collection of the movie.

The Grand Prix Trophy
